Will start accepting applications February 26, 2024

Mt SAC Flight Training Association (FTA) membership applications will be accepted through 6:00 pm March 8, 2024. The Mt SAC Flight Training Association is a student organization that operates flight-training aircraft under the supervision of the Department of Aeronautics and Transportation at Brackett Airport. Students who are currently enrolled in any credit course at our college are eligible for membership. Students not ready to apply at this time or those not accepted may reapply at the next open enrollment period. Membership briefings are required for all new and renewal members. A briefing will be held at College Aviation located at Brackett Airport on the evening of **Friday March 8, 2024 at 6:00 PM**. For those that cannot attend this briefing a computer-based-briefing can be conducted at College Aviation during business hours prior to the deadline. Those that complete this briefing should check-in with a flight dispatcher at College Aviation to be signed off as completing this requirement:

Be sure to read the Flight Training Association Regulations and Operating Procedures from the Aeronautics website prior to submitting an application. Renewal membership applications must include a copy of the flight instructor evaluation form (available at College Aviation dispatch desk).

Selection of Spring-Summer 2024 members will be notified via email by March 15, 2024. If you do not receive an email, please check our published list on our department bulletin board outside of 28B-103 or at College Aviation as we may not have your correct email address or you may have been placed on a waitlist. Once selected for membership, you will then be required to pay your \$50 membership fee at College Aviation to confirm your membership. Do not pay your membership fee until your membership selection is confirmed. Flying can begin after paying your membership fee and providing proof of citizenship. Non-US Citizens must register with the TSA prior to the start of flight training.

FTA Membership selection is competitive, so please take your time in filling out your application and provide all requested information. In addition, academic transcripts are required (unofficial accepted) and need to be uploaded with your application.
