#### Getting started: Go to inside.mtsac.edu

1 Click on "1st Time Users (Claim Account)" before you enter a username and password.



- 2 Enter your Mt. SAC username, emailed from Admissions & Records Office. Then click, "Submit."
- 3 Answer these Challenge Questions exactly as you answered them on your Mt. SAC application. If you didn't provide a Social Security Number (SSN) on your application, then enter zeroes (e.g. 0000) as your SSN. Click "submit" once you have answered all questions.
- **4** This code will be your temporary password. Write it down and then click "login."
