

Five or more hours :

- **Software** "Azar" Go to the Writing Center OR the Language Learning Center (LLC) to get started on intermediate or advanced "Azar" software for intense verb tense review.
- Verbs Boot Camp Go to the Writing Center or online at *mtsac.edu/writing center* for current boot camp schedule.
