What Comprises Study Skills Assistance?



TERC faculty and staff provide academic support to Career Tech Ed Students. The area of study skills is

comprised of a variety of tools and techniques used in the academic setting to prepare for tests, assignments, and course expectations. For example, sometimes reading a textbook for a class can weigh a student down. Often, students read a passage or a chapter in their textbook over and over without benefit. Textbook reading is an actual skill that TERC tutors are equipped to explain to students. Techniques on how to tackle
